Notice is hereby given of the decision regarding the application for Environmental Authorization in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act 107 of 1998) and the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014.

The competent authority has granted Environmental Authorization to Invest In Property 84 (Pty) Ltd to undertake activities related to mining and associated infrastructure as described in the Environmental Impact Assessment / Environmental Management Programme Report dated 7 March 2025.

A copy of the Environmental Authorization (EA), detailing the reasons for the decision and the specific conditions imposed, is attached to this letter for your review.

Any Interested and Affected party wishing to appeal against this decision must lodge a formal appeal on or before 10 April 2026. In accordance with the National Appeal Regulations, the appeal must be submitted to the Minister of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment, with concurrent copies provided to the Regional Manager of the Department of Mineral and Petroleum Resources (DMPR) and the Environmental Consultant.
